

Taunton Dog Owners Code of Conduct

1. Control Please keep your dog under close control at all times.

Close control = coming back promptly on command.
If you cannot control your dog, keep it on a lead.



Be considerate to other people, particularly children, picnickers, joggers, cyclists and fishermen.

3. Prevent excessive barking,

from your dog as it disturbs other people and wildlife.



4. Groups of dogs -

Can be intimidating to wildlife and other people.

Keep them under close control.



2. Dog Faeces

BAG it & BIN it,

In urban areas, all parks and even in the long grass.

In rural areas, prevent your dog fouling on footpaths or around car parks, if it does **BAG it & BIN it**



On areas used by grazing livestock always remove dog waste. Parasites found in dog faeces can cause livestock to abort foetuses

5. Not Everyone Likes Dogs

No matter how well behaved your dog is,

Don't allow your dog to jump up
